

It is prohibited to bring animals into the event area. It is prohibited for children or people without a driving licence to use vehicles. It is prohibited to use skateboards or similar forms of transport as it is the use of vehicles which have not been insured, although they are required to be insured in accordance with German regulations.

b) Environmental protection and noise reduction

It is absolutely prohibited by the authorities to run engines at the following times:

Saturday, 5 th September	before 8:30 and after 20:15

The Nürburgring 1927 GmbH & Co. KG and the organizer actively protect the environment throughout all areas of their respective organizations. They also expect the participants and all concerned to comply with environmental protection. Adherence to all current legal requirements regarding the environment is a basis for business.
