








END OF SESSION TRACK EXIT

For the cars in the pit lane at chequered flag: Queue in the fast lane and wait to be release, if you cannot, you go end of the pit lane (last box) and turn right to enter the paddock.

EUROPEAN SERIES















• Parc Fermé will take place within the Paddock / Awnings unless selected by the Technical Delegate for inspection

 Cars must remain under Parc Fermé conditions until released by The Stewards via the Messenging App

 Drivers required for post-race presentation must proceed to the Pitlane and will be stopped in the podium Parc Ferme area adjacent to garages 1-6

















- Cars to Pre-Grid no later than 25 minutes prior to each session
- Tyres and equipment to the Pitlane / Grid before cars are released
- Cars at 45° in the Pitlane (nose to pit exit), and park parallel for pit stops. Engine must be switched off during each pit stops.
- Cars may only move into the Fast Lane when the fast lane opens or the pit exit light is green.
- Nobody in front of the car or standing behind panels use lollipops from the working lane only
- Only the Car Controller and replacing driver are allowed in the working lane before the car stops.
- Refuelling is not permitted in the Pitlane and during any sessign





MANDATORY PIT STOP MINIMUM TIME

Pit window between 25 minutes and 34 minutes 59.99 seconds

Monza Pitlane delta time = 30 seconds

Minimum driver change time = Pitlane delta + 50 seconds = 80 seconds

Tyre change (x4) Dry to Wet (or vice versa) = 180 seconds

1 second tolerance which may be used once during the event

Don't forget to change the ID transponder.

<u>Speed in the pit lane</u>

Cars are to leave when ready to race.

Respect the pit lane speed limit, 50 Km/Hr. NO slowing or

TRACK LIMITS

the Team and the driver (warning flag) will be notified as follows:

All the offences – warning over the Team Radio **and/or** message on timing monitor after 3 infractions the car will be shown the Black/White warning flag **and/or** message over the Team Radio.

A Final warning over the Team Radio and/or message on the timing monitor

After the final warning:

RACE - The car will have a drive through penalty during the Race

FP1 & PQ - will be stopped in the session for ten minutes.

The driver have to come to the race control to see the pictures

















Please RESPECT the International Sporting Code and your fellow Competitors

Be AWARE at all times – flag signals – other cars – mirrors

Incidents during a session: "NOTED" message on timing screen



"NO INVESTIGATION NECESSARY"



"INCIDENT UNDER INVESTIGATION"

Incidents involving different categories, the higher category driver will be deemed to be at fault unless evidence clearly shows the contrary

Flashing head lights maximum 3 times between two corners










BLUE FLAG



Please respect the blue flags

During practices a fast car is about to overtake you . During the race you will be lapped .

During practices and specially qualifying if a car slow down on the racing lane it can be considered as a blocking
















INCIDENTS





- One waved Yellow flag:
- Moderate speed
- Caution some danger
- NO OVERTAKING



- Two waved Yellow flags:
- Dangerous incident has occurred
- Reduce speed, be prepared to stop
- NO OVERTAKING
























- Speed 80 Km/Hr NO weaving (Zig Zag)
- Countdown 20 seconds
 - At 10 sec FCY boards no overtake
 - At 0 sec yellow flags & all cars at 80 Km/Hr
 - RESTART on short notice 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 GREEN
- FCY normally comes before SC except during the 1st three laps
- SC gets the leader during the FCY





















PROCEDURE



Slow down to 80 Km/Hr - NO overtaking go to pit lane, the clock will NOT stop except during Qualifying and race.

During the race:

- Line up at the red line or follow the SC
- Parc Fermé conditions
- Officials ONLY on the grid unless authorised
- Restart behind SC
















RED FLAG LINE


























All cars must return to the Pit lane

Parc Ferme conditions

Driver change permitted if not already carried out

Cars will be called to Pit Exit in the order of the last full lap before the opening of the Pit Window

Race will restart behind the SC

















ALCOHOL AND DOPING

- Alcohol tolerance is 0
- Possible Checks 3 hours < session < 30' after
- Be aware of the Anti-doping regulations Check the FIA web site
