












CIRCUIT MAIN DATA

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Cars to Pre-Grid no later than 25 minutes prior to each session.
- Sessions will commence directly from the Pre-Grid via Endurance Pitlane Exit. See Stewards Bulletin.
- Cars must park parallel for short pit stops and at 45° for longer work. Engine must be switched off during pit stops. Cars at 45° (nose to pit exit) between Q1 & Q2 and during Red Flags.
- During a red flag and the period between Q1 and Q2, cars may only move into the Fast Lane once the FAST LANE OPEN signal is given or the pit exit is Green
- Nobody in front of the car or standing behind panels use lollipops from the working lane only
- Only the Car Controller and replacing driver are allowed in the working lane before the car stops.
- Refuelling is not permitted in the Pitlane and during any session
- End of sessions, after taking the chequered flag cars should enter the Pitlane at T19 and proceed to the Pit Exit, following Marshals instructions.



















PARC FERME

- Parc Fermé will take place within the Paddock / Awnings unless selected by the Technical Delegate for inspection, which will take place in the GT4 Scrutineering area
- SD Cards must be deposited in GT4 Scrutineering within 20 minutes
- Cars must remain under Parc Fermé conditions until released by The Stewards via the Messenging App
- Drivers required for post-race presentation will be stopped in front of Endurance Pitlane Podium. Teams to immediately remove cars to the Paddock / GT4 Scrutineering under Parc Fermé conditions.













MANDATORY PIT STOP MINIMUM TIME

Pit window between 25 mn and 34 mn 59.99 seconds

Spa Pitlane delta time = 71 seconds

Minimum driver change time = Pitlane delta + 50 seconds = **121 seconds**

Tyres change (x4) only if authorised = 180 seconds (dry to wet or wet to dry)

1 second tolerance which may be used once during the event

Please notify Race Control via the Messaging App if using the tolerance

Minimum speed in the pit lane

Cars are to leave when ready to race.

Respect the pit lane speed limit, 50 Km/Hr. NO slowing or stopping
























SIGNALLING AREA & CONTROL LINE

Please keep right after Turn 18 if entering the Pitlane






















PIT ENTRY SPEED LIMIT LINE







DRIVER ETIQUETTE

Be AWARE at all times – flag signals – other cars – mirrors

Incidents during a session: "NOTED" message on timing screen

"NO INVESTIGATION NECESSARY " "INCIDENT

UNDER INVESTIGATION"

Incidents involving different categories, the higher category driver will be deemed to be at fault unless evidence clearly shows the contrary

Flashing head lights maximum 3 times between two corners






















INCIDENTS



- Moderate speed
- Caution some danger

Two waved Yellow flags:

- Dangerous incident has occurred
- Reduce speed, be prepared to stop

- Speed 80 Km/Hr NO weaving (Zig Zag)
 - (for practices) RESTART on short notice 5, 4, 3, 2,1 GREEN
- (RACE) FCY will be follow by SC
- except during the 1st three laps Directly SC
- SC gets the leader during the FCY




















SAFETY CAR

SC may use the Pitlane























PROCEDURE

Slow down to 80 Km/Hr - NO overtaking go to pit lane, the clock will NOT stop except during Qualifying

During the race:

- Line up at the red line or follow the SC
- Parc Fermé conditions
- Officials ONLY on the grid unless authorised
- Restart behind SC




























DURING PIT WINDOW

All cars must return to the Pit lane _ RD by radio

Parc Fermé conditions

Driver change permitted if not already carried out

Cars will be called to Pit Exit in the order of the last full lap before the opening of the Pit Window

Race will restart behind the SC

FIA rule (contact with the white line) - NO tolerance

 Teams are reminded that both, warnings and penalties, are given to the Car


















TRACK LIMITS























TRACK LIMITS PENALTIES

- 1.FP & Pre-Qual: drivers will be warned and stopped, if necessary, lap times can be deleted.
- 2. Qualifying: every lap time will be deleted.
- 3. Race: 3 first time warning on the timing monitors,

4th time warning flag.

5th time final warning on the radio, At the

6th time the stewards can impose a time penalty of 5s.
