
**(1) Driver Categorisation Derogations:**


#66 CINDY GUDET Silver to Bronze\* with Gabriela JILKOVA (Silver) PRO-AM

We hereby certify that the driver **NOAM ABRAMCZYK**

categorised as **SILVER** according to the official 2024 FIA Driver Categorisation list, will exceptionally be categorised as **Bronze\*** for the Jeddah round of the 2024 GT4 European Series to compete with **AV Racing** in the following line-up :

PRO-AM category with **PAUL PETIT (SILVER)**

This derogation is not valid for any other Series or event and will not be automatically carried forward to any other round of the 2024 season. This categorisation will revert to **SILVER** should the above named driver change **team, car or co-drivers** for the event in question.

Teams and drivers are reminded that according to the GT4 EUROPEAN SERIES POWERED BY RAFA RACING CLUB Sporting regulations, the performance of any drivers and line-ups which have received a derogation will be monitored by the SRO Sporting Board and may be removed without notice, and that pit-stop time penalties may be awarded at any point up until one hour before the start of the race.
