The Stewards, having received a report from the Technical Delegate, summoned and heard from the driver(s) and the competitor's representative(s), have considered the following matter and determine the following:

Fact: Alleged Technical Non Compliance - Car underweight

Offence: Aleged Breach of Article 3.3, 28 of the GT4 European Series Sporting

Regulations

Decision: No Further Action

Reason: Car #96 was found to be under the minimum weight imposed by the BOP + Driver ballast.

The average minimum weight measured was 1492 kg instead of the mandatory 1496 kg. It can be noted that some small bodywork and trim parts were missing on the car due to several incidents occured during the Race 2. Taking in consideration the tolerance of the scales, which in this occasion is 2,98 kg, the Stewards conclude, according to article 28.2 of the GT4 Eu. Sport. Regs., that the difficiency in weight results from the accidental loss

of the components of the car occured during the race.

The Competitor/Driver was summoned and heard before the decision was taken.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
