

TRACK ACCESS / EXIT





Exit from track at end of session

From the Pre-grid, enter the track and proceed directly to the Pit lane

After the chequered flag, cars will exit the track via the gate before T13

Pit equipment will enter the Pit lane via the gate adjacent to the Pit Entry

Pit equipment and any cars in the Pitlane at the chequered flag will return to the Paddock via the gate adjacent to box 26







GENERAL INFORMATION



- Cars to Pre-Grid no later than 25 minutes prior to each session. Cars will be placed in order of the pitlane allocation during the pre-grid procedure
- Maximum of 3 team personnel + drivers on the Grid
- Cars at 45° in the Pitlane at the start of each session (nose to pit exit)
- Cars must park parallel for short pit stops and at 45° for longer work. Engine must be switched off during pit stops.
- Cars may only move into the Fast Lane once the pit exit is Green and for this
 event may only be released starting with the car closest to the Pit Exit
- Nobody in front of the car or standing behind panels use lollipops from the working lane only
- Only the Car Controller and replacing driver are allowed in the working lane before the car stops.
- Refuelling is not permitted in the Pitlane and during any session

PARC FERME



 Parc Ferme will take place within the Paddock / Awnings unless selected by the Technical Delegate for inspection

 Cars must remain under Parc Ferme conditions until released by The Stewards via the Messenging App

• Drivers required for post-race presentation will be directed to the Pitlane via Turn 13/14 after each race. Please have a team member available to immediately remove the car to the GT4 Paddock / GT4 Scrutineeting Area.



MANDATORY PIT STOP MINIMUM TIME



Please see Sporting Note 1 for this event

Pit window (Silver Cup) between 23 minutes and 29 minutes 59.99 seconds Pit window (Pro-Am) between 30 minutes and 36 minutes 59.99 seconds Pit window (Am) between 25 minutes and 34 minutes 59.99 seconds

Zandvoort Pitlane delta time = 27 seconds

Minimum driver change time = Pitlane delta + 65 seconds = 92 seconds

Tyre change (x4) only if authorised = Pitlane delta + 95 seconds = 122 seconds

1 second tolerance which may be used once during the event

Please notify Race Control via the Messaging App if using the tolerance

Minimum speed in the pit lane

Cars are to leave when ready to race.

Respect the pit lane speed limit, 50 Km/Hr. NO slowing or stopping






SIGNALLING AREA & CONTROL LINE







DRIVER ETIQUETTE



Please RESPECT the International Sporting Code and your fellow Competitors

Be AWARE at all times – flag signals – other cars – mirrors

Incidents during a session: "NOTED" message on timing screen



"NO INVESTIGATION NECESSARY "



"INCIDENT UNDER INVESTIGATION"

Incidents involving different categories, the higher category driver will be deemed to be at fault unless evidence clearly shows the contrary


Flashing head lights maximum 3 times between two corners





INCIDENTS





One waved Yellow flag:

- Moderate speed
- Caution some danger
- NO OVERTAKING

Two waved Yellow flags:

- Dangerous incident has occurred
- Reduce speed, be prepared to stop
- NO OVERTAKING













- Speed 80 Km/Hr NO weaving (Zig Zag)
- Countdown 20 seconds
 - At 10 sec FCY boards
 - At 0 sec yellow flags & all cars at 80 Km/Hr
 - RESTART on short notice 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 GREEN
- FCY normally precedes SC except during the 1st three laps
- SC gets the leader during the FCY






SAFETY CAR

SC may use the Pitlane











Slow down to 80 Km/Hr - NO overtaking go to pit lane, the clock will NOT stop except during Qualifying

During the race:

- Line up at the red line or follow the SC
- Parc Ferme conditions
- Officials ONLY on the grid unless authorised
- Restart behind SC

If you enter the pits after the red flag: restart one lap later





RED FLAG LINE













All cars must return to the Pit lane

Parc Ferme conditions

Driver change permitted if not already carried out

Cars will be called to Pit Exit in the order of the last full lap before the opening of the Pit Window

Race will restart behind the SC




