The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having examined video evidence, summoned and heard from the competitor's representatives, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No. / Driver: 14 / Clement Seyler and 27 / Cesar Gazeau

Competitor: Sainteloc Junior Team & Konstantin Lachenauer

Time (fact): 16:51 hrs

Session: Race 1

Fact: Collision between cars 14 and 27 at turn 7

Regulation: Article 33.4 of the GT4 European Series Sporting Regulations and Article 2d) of Appendix L Chapter IV of the FIA International Sporting Code

Decision: **No further action**

Reason: Cars 14 and 27 made side-to-side contact approaching turn 7. Car 27 spun off into the gravel whilst car 14 sustained a slow puncture which ultimately led to the car retiring from the race. Having summoned and heard from both drivers and competitors' representatives and having viewed TV and on-board video evidence, the Stewards consider that neither driver was wholly or predominantly responsible for the collision and therefore determine that no further action is appropriate in this instance.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
